

Dear GREET Workshop Participant,

A GREET workshop is offered at Argonne National Laboratory October 15-16, 2015. Below is some information that you might find useful for your visit.

- For directions from the airport to Argonne campus, [please use this link](#) if arriving at O'Hare airport, [or that link](#) if arriving at Midway airport.
- If renting a car from O'Hare airport and using the highway to arrive at Argonne, there are several toll stations which require cash for toll payment.
- If taking a cab from the airport, you may avoid a 50% surcharge on metered rate if you reserve ahead of arrival and request the [flat rate](#) to Argonne Labs. - If you are staying at the Argonne Guest House (Building 460) and will be arriving after 5:00 pm on October 14, please proceed to the security check by the main Entrance Gate (north entrance from Cass Ave) to receive your pass. If arriving during the day (before 5:00pm), please stop by the Visitor Reception center at the end of the main Entrance Gate to pick your gate pass before proceeding to the security gate. There will also be signs to guide visitors from the main Entrance Gate and from the Guest House to the conference location.
- When staying onsite of Argonne, the Argonne Guest House restaurant at building 460 (phone: 800-632-8990) serves breakfast, lunch and dinner. The Argonne Cafeteria (building 213) serves breakfast and lunch. Please refer to the following link to view the location of the Guest House and Cafeteria on the [Argonne Campus map](#).
